

## Obligated Projects - FHWA and FTA

MPOs need to post a list of 2025 obligated projects within their planning area by March 31, 2026.

### Annual listing of [obligated projects](#). 23 CFR § 450.334

(a) In metropolitan planning areas, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year, the [State](#), public transportation operator(s), and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under [23 U.S.C.](#) or [49 U.S.C.](#) were obligated in the preceding program year.

(b) The listing shall be prepared in accordance with [§ 450.314\(a\)](#) and shall include all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year, and shall at a minimum include the TIP information under [§ 450.326\(g\)\(1\) and \(4\)](#) and identify, for each project, the amount of Federal funds requested in the TIP, the Federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and the Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.

(c) The listing shall be published or otherwise made available in accordance with the MPO's public participation criteria for the TIP.

The tables contain the basic reference data for funding awards issued to direct funding recipients in Wisconsin in CY 2025.

The purpose of the annual listing is to increase public accountability and transparency in the TIP process at the local level. The key requisite of this publication is that each obligated project listed is relevant to the MPO's local area and connected back to the TIP. This includes the funding programs used and contains a clear and transparent description of the federally funded project and includes any other relevant local project selection and TIP information to the extent practicable. The MPO worked with Metro Ride and the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT) to obtain the data for their region and present it to the public in a clear and accessible way that delivers transparency in government spending and promotes public participation in the TIP process.
